AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF PORTLAND OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND FINANCE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,500,000 FOR DEBT MANAGEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Portland Development Commission ("PDC"), as the duly-designated urban renewal agency of the City of Portland (the "City"), is granted broad powers under Oregon Revised Statutes 457.170 for the planning and implementation of urban renewal projects;

WHEREAS, the City Office of Management and Finance ("OMF") provides all debt issuance and management services for the City and PDC;

WHEREAS, PDC and OMF entered into an intergovernmental agreement ("IGA") to clarify and document services and payment procedures for fiscal year ("FY") 2013-14 for an amount not to exceed \$259,707; and

WHEREAS, PDC and OMF amended the IGA in FY 2014-15 for an amount not to exceed \$540,000;

WHEREAS, PDC and OMF amended the IGA in FY 2015-16 for an amount not to exceed \$828,409;

WHEREAS, OMF will perform similar debt issuance and management services for PDC in FY 2016-17 through FY 2020-21 for an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the PDC Board of Commissioners authorizes the Executive Director to enter into an IGA amendment with OMF for FY 2016-17 through FY 2020-21, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Director may approve changes to the IGA if such changes, in the opinion of the Executive Director in consultation with the General Counsel, do not materially change PDC's obligations or risks; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

AMENDMENT No. 4 to INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT No. 30003671 (Debt Management Services)

This AMENDMENT No. 4 amends INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT No. 30003671 ("Agreement") between the CITY OF PORTLAND, OREGON, OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND FINANCE ("OMF") and the PORTLAND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION ("PDC") as follows:

- 1. The term of the Agreement is extended until June 30, 2021.
- 2. Section III (A) is amended to provide that PDC agrees to pay OMF an additional sum not to exceed ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,500,000) for debt management services described in Section 1 of the Agreement which were rendered between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2021. Of this amount, NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$900,000) are Service Delivery Funds as defined in the Agreement. The remaining amount of SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$600,000) is to cover debt issuance costs and costs for outside legal services necessarily incurred by OMF in providing debt management services.

All other terms and provisions of the Agreement remain unchanged.
