Enterprise Zone Tax Abatement:

The E-Zone boundary has been amended to include much of downtown Portland. Qualified firms that will be making a substantial new capital investment may be eligible for a waiver of 100 percent of the amount of real property taxes attributable to the new investment for a five-year period after completion.
