# 7. Action Item: Resolution 7627 and 7628 - Approving Building Conversion and Community Anchor Destination Energy Efficiency Loan Program Guidelines

Prosper Portland staff presenting this item: Lisa Abuaf, Director Development & Investment Kay Little Jr., Investment Manager

With these actions, the Board approved the Portland Clean Energy Fund Central City Building Conversion – Embodied Carbon Pilot Loan and Central City Community Anchor Destination Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Loan program guidelines (collectively, Guidelines). These Guidelines direct program funding with resources provided to Prosper Portland pursuant to an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA)



between the City of Portland Bureau of Planning and Sustainability through the Clean Energy Community Benefits Fund (PCEF)) and Prosper Portland.

Ms. Abuaf reviewed the four key areas included in the IGA, along with the timeline of partnership efforts with PCEF, the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality, and others.

Mr. Little provided details around the Guidelines of the programs and outlined eligibility and terms for the Anchor Destination Program.

Commissioner Hagins requested a follow-up report on what projects occur as a result of the programs.

Commissioner Slick inquired about the strategic thinking and planning around locations and activations.

Ms. Abuaf noted the project is a pilot moment to help inform and right size.

Sam Baraso, Program Manager for PCEF, stated that the pilots are an opportunity to learn.

Commissioner Slick asked staff to consider the multi-layering impact and challenges, not solely embodied carbon savings, by choosing buildings that have strategic importance, and referenced regulatory challenges such as the City's decision to favor life and safety performance level over conversion incentives within City Code.

Chair Cruz asked whether staff are engaging in code changes with partner bureaus.

Ms. Abuaf noted that it is a discussion that can be revisited with the new Mayor and City Council.

Chair Cruz called for a motion to approve Resolutions No. 7627, Commissioner Hagins moved, and Commissioner Stoudamire Wesley seconded the motion.
