RESOLUTION NO. 7029

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH THE CITY OF PORTLAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING AND ADMINISTERING THE ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY INITIATIVE PROGRAM DURING FISCAL YEAR 2013-14

WHEREAS, Portland Development Commission ("PDC") is charged by the City of Portland ("City") Charter with implementing the vision and goals of the City as adopted by City Council relating to economic development;

WHEREAS, in carrying out this charge, the City Charter directs PDC to advance social equity and involve the City's constituencies to create, maintain, and promote a diverse, sustainable community in which economic prosperity and employment opportunities are made available to all residents;

WHEREAS, beginning in fiscal year ("FY") 2009-10, PDC has received annual federal Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funding from the City to operate the Economic Opportunity Initiative ("EOI") program;

WHEREAS, the EOI program is an economic development program operated by PDC that is designed to assist low-income, multi-barriered individuals to increase their incomes by providing workforce development and microenterprise development services combined with wrap-around supports;

WHEREAS, the EOI program supports achievement of the PDC 2010-14 Revised Strategic Plan and the Neighborhood Economic Development Strategy adopted by City Council in May 2011;

WHEREAS, beginning in FY 2009-10, PDC has received annual federal CDBG funding from the City to operate the EOI program;

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2013, the PDC Board of Commissioners, through resolution no. 7006, authorized the Executive Director to enter into the Subrecipient Contract with the City, acting by and through the Portland Housing Bureau ("PHB"), providing up to \$2,400,000 in CDBG funding to PDC; and

WHEREAS, PDC desires to receive additional CDBG funding from the City to assist in implementing the EOI program during the 2013-14 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Director is hereby authorized to enter into the Subrecipient Contract Amendment with the City, acting by and through PHB, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, providing approximately \$2,690,000 in CDGB funding to PDC for the purpose of implementing and managing the EOI program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Director may approve changes to the Subrecipient Contract Amendment prior to and subsequent to execution, so long as such changes do not materially increase PDC's risks or obligations, as determined by the Executive Director in consultation with the General Counsel; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become effective 30 days after its adoption.

DRAFT AMENDMENT NO. 1

Subrecipient Contract No. 30003462

The above referenced Subrecipient Contract between the City of Portland (City) acting by and through its Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) and Portland Housing Bureau (Subrecipient) is hereby amended as follows:

Funding

Increase funding by a total of \$447,300 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for the Economic Opportunity Initiative. Part A: CONTRACT AGREEMENT, item 2 and Table A are amended as follows:

2. **COMPENSATION**: City shall pay Subrecipient monthly for provision of services, upon receipt of invoice documenting expenditures. Total compensation under this Contract shall not exceed TWO MILLION SIX HUNDRED AND EIGHTY EIGHT THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY DOLLARS (\$2,688,690).
