#### **RESOLUTION NO. 6621**

ADOPT A MINOR AMENDMENT TO THE INTERSTATE CORRIDOR URBAN RENEWAL PLAN – FIFTH  $(5^{TH})$  AMENDMENT IDENTIFYING NINE PROPERTIES FOR ACQUISITION

**WHEREAS**, the Portland City Council adopted the Interstate Corridor Urban Renewal Plan on August 23, 2001 by Ordinance No. 174829 to provide tax increment funding and urban renewal authority to foster the redevelopment of the area around the Interstate Corridor, which plan has been amended through the Fourth Amendment (as amended, the "Plan");

**WHEREAS**, the Plan authorizes the acquisition of property from a willing seller upon a finding that the acquisition is consistent with the objectives of the Plan;

**WHEREAS**, if the property is not identified in the Plan for acquisition, the Board must adopt a minor amendment to the Plan identifying the property and setting forth a schedule for its acquisition and disposition;

**WHEREAS**, on May 28, 2008, the Board approved the acquisition of twenty single family residences currently owned by the Housing Authority of Portland (HAP); nine of these properties are located within the Interstate Urban Renewal Area;

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that this acquisition is consistent with the goals of the Plan and in the public interest, as identified in the Report accompanying this Resolution and the Board documents approving the acquisition; and

**WHEREAS**, the disposition plan for these properties will be brought back to the Board for approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Plan shall be amended to add nine single family residences currently owned by HAP, as set forth in the established acquisition and disposition schedule and attached as Exhibit A;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Executive Director shall cause notice of the adoption of the Fifth Amendment to be published in accordance with ORS 457.115 in the newspaper having the greatest circulation in the City of Portland within four days following adoption of this Resolution; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
