




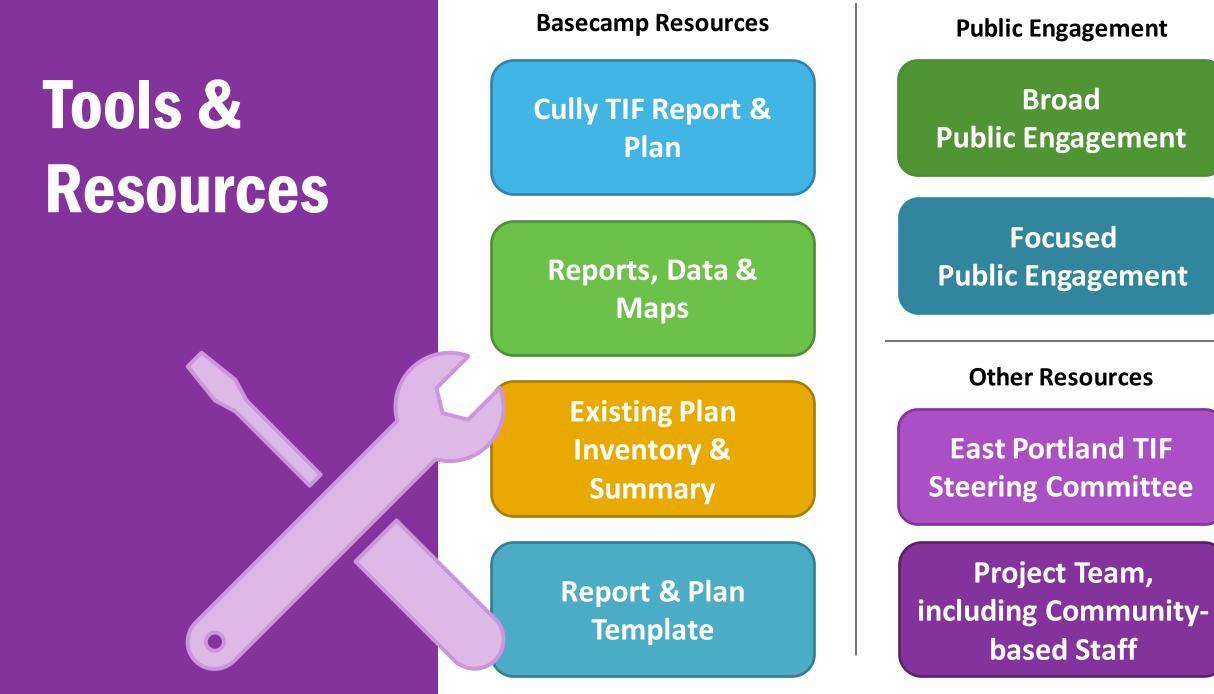




Prevent displacement of vulnerable people, communities, businesses and community-based institutions

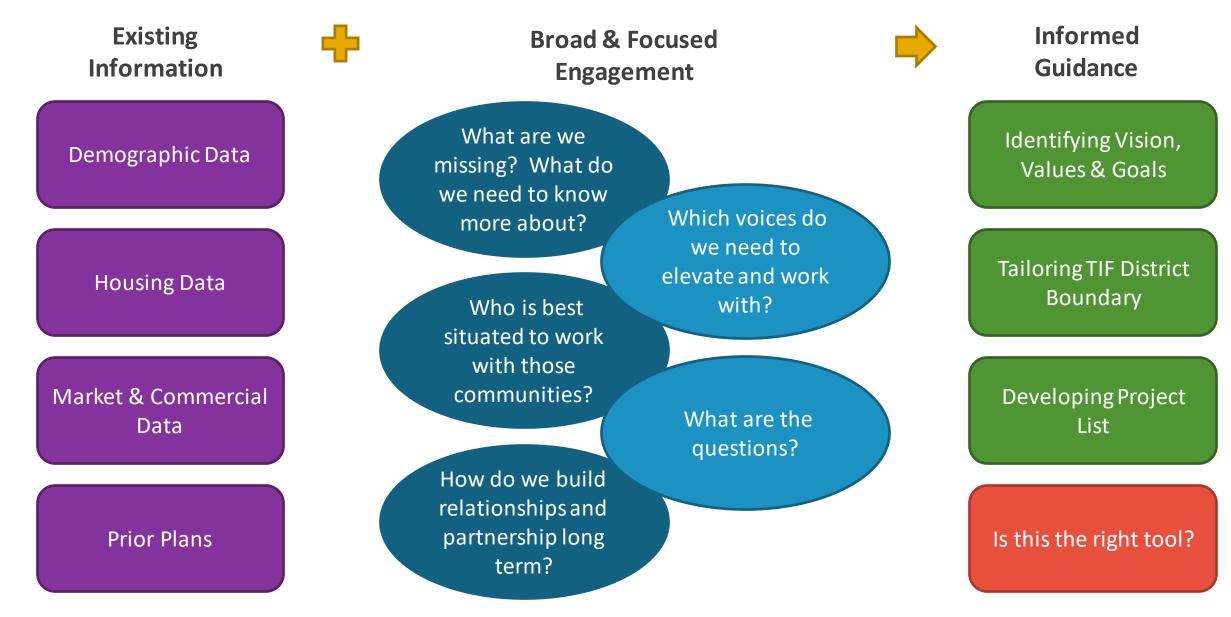
Actively work to **remove barriers** that could preclude folks from accessing resources.


